

4 Seasons SPC Flooring Care Guide

4. Scuff Marks and Tough Stains:

• For scuff marks or stubborn stains, gently scrub the affected area with a soft cloth or sponge. Be cautious not to use abrasive scouring pads, as they can scratch the surface.

5. Avoid Excessive Moisture:

• SPC flooring is water-resistant, but it's essential to clean up any water or liquid spills promptly. Standing water or excessive moisture can potentially seep into seams or under the flooring, causing damage.

6. Furniture Protection:

• Use furniture pads or felt protectors under the legs of your furniture to prevent scratches and indentations. Lift furniture when moving it instead of dragging it across the floor.

7. Mats and Rugs:

 Place mats or rugs at entryways to trap dirt and prevent it from being tracked onto the SPC flooring. Ensure that these mats are non-staining and have a non-slip backing to prevent damage. Any damage caused by matts are not covered in the manufacturers warranty.

8. Avoid High Heels and Sharp Objects:

 High heels, sharp objects, and heavy items can damage SPC flooring. Use caution when walking in high heels, and avoid dropping or dragging sharp or heavy items across the floor. Any damage caused by heels or impact is not covered in the manufacturers' warranty.

9. Regular Inspections:

• Periodically inspect your SPC flooring for any signs of damage or wear. If you notice any problems, address them promptly to prevent further deterioration.

10. UV Protection:

• SPC flooring is highly UV-resistant, but prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading over time and bubbling. Use curtains, blinds, or UV-protective window films to minimize this effect. This is required by the manufacturers' warranty.

- Avoid waxing or polishing SPC flooring, as it has a factory-applied wear layer that doesn't require these treatments.
- Do not use a steam mop on spc flooring it will delaminate the finish
